

We had EUR 3.499,22 at the beginning of the year and ended the year with EUR 3.926,73 resulting in a total gain of EUR 427,51.


Due to the corona pandemic continued effect there was again very little financial action in 2021.

We received **EUR 1.000,-** from our CING mother for the planned AGM in Brussels 2021 which then did not take place.




Gains and losses CING-CE from 2010 to 2021
