Nominations for the Gustaf Dalén medalist 2026

The Gustaf Dalén medal is awarded yearly in memory of “the Chalmerist”, the entrepreneur and Nobel Prize winner Gustaf Dalén (1869-1937). He was awarded the Nobel Prize in physics 1912.

All members of Chalmersska Ingenjörsföreningen are now welcome to nominate candidates for the 2026 Gustaf Dalén Medal. The award can only be given to individuals with a degree from Chalmers University of Technology.

We would like to see nominations for medalists active in universities and colleges as well as in the business community, and in other ways linked to Chalmers' areas of expertise. See (<https://avancez.se/om-oss/gustaf-dalen>) for a list of previous recipients of the medal.

The Gustaf Dalén medal is awarded to only one person a year. Your nomination is therefore of utmost importance!

The nomination may be brief, about an A4 page according to the template proposal, (<https://avancez.se/om-oss/gustaf-dalen>), but in order for us to be able to process the proposal, it is necessary that it contains:

- Brief summary motivation
- Curriculum vitae with a short personal description including birth data, educations, positions and other important activities and assignments

NOTE! For older nominations then 5 years (before 2022) a new nomination for the person is mandatory.
